
Dynamic Discipling: Counseling Prevention and Follow Up

I. New Testament principles

A portrait of Christ-centered discipleship is "framed" by four principles:

Biblical Teaching



Loving Relationships

Ministry Involvement

Personal Accountability

The relevance of the Great Commission: Matt. 28:18-20

Christ-centered: The countenance of the portrait is attributed to the Spirit of Christ who indwells every true believer (Rom. 8:11). Here is the *dynamic* source of spiritual growth: "Christ in you, the hope of glory" (Col. 1:27; Phil. 2:13; John 14:17,18).

Grace-oriented: "Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and *learn* from Me ..." (Matt. 11:28,29).

- Loving Relationships: John 13:1; 15:12,13; Mark 3:14; Deut. 6:5-7
- Ministry Involvement: Luke 9:1-10; 10:1; Matt. 4:19; John 20:21; 1 Peter 2:9
- Personal Accountability: Luke 10:17-20; 2 Cor. 5:10

Dynamic Discipling: Counseling Prevention and Follow Up

Consider your discipleship journey in light of the following *contexts or spheres*:

Sphere 1: Personal walk

Sphere 2: One to one

Sphere 3: Small groups

Sphere 4: Congregational worship

Sphere 5: Inter-church/inter-denominational /inter-ministry networking

II. The relationship of grace discipleship to Exchanged Life counseling

Proactive: The fuller message of the Cross and identification with Christ should be normative in discipling new believers. Balanced [see above], dynamic discipling will significantly reduce the need for counseling!

Follow up: After a counselee enters into victory and concludes the formal counseling process, if there is no ongoing dynamic discipleship, he/she will be more vulnerable to "downers." Spheres 1,2,3 [above] are vital contexts to encourage continued renewal and spiritual growth (2 Pet. 3:18).
